

Palm Beach County *Ethics Awareness Day*

WHEREAS, the mission of the Palm Beach County Commission on Ethics is to foster integrity in public service, to promote the public trust and confidence in those services, and to prevent conflicts between private interest and public duty, and;

WHEREAS, in November 2010, seventy-two percent of Palm Beach County voters approved a referendum extending the jurisdiction of the Commission on Ethics and Code of Ethics to all 38 municipalities within the county, and;

WHEREAS, in July 2011, the National Association of Counties awarded Palm Beach County an NACo Achievement Award for its sweeping ethics reform programs, and;

WHEREAS, the Commission on Ethics seeks to accomplish its mission through conducting ongoing educational programs and community outreach, and;

WHEREAS, Palm Beach County asks that all citizens join in learning more about the Ethics movement in Palm Beach County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this ____ day of _____, 2011, that November 18 in Palm Beach County is hereby declared:
