Public Report and Administrative Order of Dismissal

Complainant, Dennis Lipp, filed a complaint on November 14, 2014, alleging a possible ethics violation involving Respondent, Ryan Laing.

Commission staff investigated this matter and prepared a Memorandum of Inquiry. Under Rule of Procedure 4.2(d), the Executive Director determined that the complaint was legally insufficient and forwarded all supporting documents to the Commission on January 16, 2015.
