Christie Kelley, Executive Director of the Palm Beach County Commission on Ethics (COE), filed the above-referenced complaint against Respondent, Carolyn Cassidy, a Commissioner for the Town of Ocean Ridge, alleging that Respondent used or attempted to use her position in a manner that may have resulted in a special financial benefit to herself or her outside business in violation of Section 2-443(a) of the Palm Beach County Code of Ethics.

Pursuant to Sec. 2-258(a)1 of the Palm Beach County Commission on Ethics Ordinance, the COE is empowered to enforce the Palm Beach County Code of Ethics.

In lieu of a probable cause hearing, the COE advocate recommended the issuance of a letter of instruction and a dismissal of the complaint. This recommendation is based on the Respondent's self-reporting of the incident and the facts elicited in the investigation.

Pursuant to Commission on Ethics Ordinance Sec. 2-260.3(b), Dismissal of complaints, the complaint may be dismissed and a letter of instruction issued at this stage of the proceedings if the Commission finds that the violation was inadvertent, unintentional, or insubstantial.

Therefore it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the complaint against Respondent, Carolyn Cassidy, is hereby DISMISSED and a Letter of Instruction is issued.
