Tilapia & Cichlid Rodeo Roundup for Pelican Lake

Juno Beach -- April 26, 2025

The Goal: To reduce numbers of invasive Cichlids and Tilapias in Pelican Lake, where they compete with more beneficial species. Once this is done, the lake can be stocked with the good guys!

Who will compete: There will be five teams. Teams can have up to five anglers; ideally, all will be ages 6 to 18. Each team must have an adult Team Leader.

Our Team Sponsoring Partners: Blue Water Surfing, Dive-In Adventures, Groundswell Surf Shop, Juno Bait & Tackle, and TerMarsh Groves. *To join one of the teams, sign up at one of these sponsors locations.*

When and Where: Meet by the gazebo at the north end of Pelican Lake in Juno Beach. Check in begins at 7 am. Any angler over age 15 as well as each Team Leader must show their Florida fishing license. At 7:15, teams will draw lots to learn their assigned starting station around the lake. The "Lines in" call will be at 7:30. Every half hour, each team rotates to the next station around the lake.

Team requirements: Each angler must come with bait and tackle and have their personal catch bag/bucket. Each Team Leader must have a text able cell phone. All participants must sign off on a separate, detailed agreement.

Fishing rules: Only cichlids and tilapia may be caught. It's up to the team to remove hooks. Other species must be live released or the team risks disqualification. All tackle International Game Fish Association rules apply as do state and county regulations.

How to win: The "Lines Up" call to stop fishing will be at 11 am. Each team then brings its catch to the counting station by the gazebo.
